COMMON NAME	SCIENTIFIC NAME	LIGHT	MOISTURE	HEIGHT (ft.)	NOTES
SPRING AND SUMMER BERRIES					
Serviceberry/Shadbush	<i>Amelanchier spp.</i>	Full Sun-Full Shade	Dry to Wet	8	Salt tolerant, susceptible to rust, sometimes browsed by deer
Red Mulberry	<i>Morus rubra</i>	Full Sun-Full Shade	Dry to Wet	35-50	Drought tolerant
Black Cherry/Wild Cherry	<i>Prunus serotina</i>	Full Sun-Full Shade	Dry to Wet	50-80	Susceptible to leaf spot, powdery mildew, black knot, tent caterpillars, and Japanese beetles
AUTUMN BERRIES					
Spicebush	<i>Lindera benzoin</i>	Full Sun-Full Shade	Moist to Wet	8	Separate sexes (red berries on females)
Red Twig Dogwood	<i>Cornus sericea</i>	Full Sun to Part Shade	Moist to Wet	4	Deer may browse
Fragrant Sumac	<i>Rhus aromatica</i>	Full Sun-Full Shade	Dry to Moist	5	Rarely browsed by deer, drought tolerant
Staghorn Sumac	<i>Rhus typhina</i>	Full Sun to Part Shade	Dry to Medium	15-25	Drought tolerant, spread 20-30 feet
American Elder/Elderberry	<i>Sambucus canadensis</i>	Full Sun-Full Shade	Medium to Wet	5-12	Not generally preferred by deer
AUTUMN TO WINTER BERRIES					
Smooth Witherod Viburnum	<i>Viburnum nudum</i>	Full Sun to Part Shade	Dry to Wet	9	Not generally preferred by deer
Red Chokeberry	<i>Aronia arbutifolia</i>	Full Sun to Part Shade	Dry to Wet	9	Drought tolerant, irresistible to deer
Winterberry	<i>Ilex verticillata</i>	Full Sun-Full Shade	Dry to Wet	7	Separate sexes needed, browsed by deer
American Holly	<i>Ilex opaca</i>	Full Sun to Part Shade	Moderate	40-50	Should be planted in multiples of 4 or more to allow for cross-pollination to produce the red berries
Eastern Red Cedar	<i>Juniperus virginiana</i>	Full Sun to Part Shade	Dry to Wet	70	Separate sexes needed, browsed by deer
Northern Bayberry	<i>Morella caroliniensis</i>	Full Sun to Part Shade	Dry to Wet	14	Deer do not readily browse
American Beautyberry	<i>Callicarpa americana</i>	Full Sun to Part Shade	Moderate	3-6	Showy, violet to magenta berries
Crab Apple	<i>Malus sargentii</i>	Full Sun	Moderate	6-8	Blooms in alternate years, some drought tolerance
Virginia Creeper/Woodbine	<i>Parthenocissus quinquefolia</i>	Full Sun to Part Shade	Moderate	30-50 vine	Can tolerate full shade, deer tolerant, do not grow on wood or shingle walls
